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ABOUT THE SHOW

Next to Normal is a gripping, raw, and heart-wrenching rock musical that first stormed onto the stage in 2008, with a powerful score by Tom Kitt and an emotionally charged book and lyrics by Brian Yorkey. The story revolves around Diana Goodman, a mother whose battle with increasingly severe bipolar disorder casts a shadow over her family's life. As Diana's mental health deteriorates, we are drawn into a world of complex emotions, where love, loss, and desperation collide.

The musical dives deep into the haunting realities of grief, depression, and the dark consequences of untreated mental illness, offering an unflinching look at the toll it takes on both the individual and their loved ones. *Next to Normal* doesn't shy away from tough topics such as suicide, addiction, and the ethical dilemmas within modern psychiatric care, while also exploring the undercurrent of pain that often lurks beneath the seemingly perfect surface of suburban life.

With its electrifying rock score and its poignant exploration of the human psyche, *Next to Normal* is a rare theatrical experience. It's not just a musical; it's a cathartic journey into the heart of what it means to be human.

DIANA

Delusional, bipolar, and depressed. The sexiness of her yesterdays has only recently begun to soften. She is determined to make her family perfect but is tortured by a death in the family. Gender: Female Age: 35 to 45

GABE

Diana & Dan's son. Dashing, athletic, and bright. He is a playful man and everything a mother could imagine. Gender: Male Age: 18 to 25 Vocal range top: C5 Vocal range bottom: B2

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CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

DAN

Diana's husband. He is handsome and genuine. Though a constant in Diana's tumultuous life, he has grown tired and weary of her antics. Gender: Male Age: 35 to 45 Vocal range top: B4 Vocal range bottom: Ab2

HENRY

Natalie's classmate. The all-around musician, philosopher, and slacker. He has an intoxicating capacity for sympathy and romance. Gender: Male Age: 17 to 20 Vocal range top: B4 Vocal range bottom: G#2

NATALIE

Diana & Dan's troubled daughter. An accomplished pianist and hardworking student, her struggles are exacerbated by her mother's behavior. She greatly admires Henry. Gender: Female Age: 17 to 20 Vocal range top: G5 Vocal range bottom: G3

DR. MADDEN

Diana's handsome psychiatrist. Quite assured in his practice and considered somewhat of a rock star. Gender: Male Age: 30 to 40 Vocal range top: A4 Vocal range bottom: A2

We will also be casting an enesemble of four performers for this show, we will be looking for 2 male and 2 female performers to make up the ensemble.



CONTENT WARNING

We would like to make all auditionees aware that Next to Normal addresses sensitive and potentially triggering themes. The show explores complex and emotionally challenging subjects, and we want to ensure that all participants are fully informed before auditioning.

Mental Illness: The musical portrays a family coping with the effects of bipolar disorder, with scenes depicting emotional breakdowns, hospitalisations, and the challenges of living with a mental health condition.

Substance Abuse: Characters struggle with addiction, which plays a significant role in the story.

Suicide: The musical touches on themes of grief and loss, including the impact of suicide on the family.

Grief and Trauma: The narrative includes raw portrayals of personal loss, and characters struggle with unresolved trauma.

This production contains moments of intense emotion, graphic themes, and adult language. We encourage anyone auditioning to carefully consider their own emotional comfort and well-being before participating.
